Here's how to help:


- Send coins or spare notes into class (zip lock bag please)

It is easy to order. The Book Club LOOP platform for parents allows you to pay by credit card. Your child's order is submitted directly to school, safe and sound, and the books will be delivered to class. ## Fresh Box Organics

### Chevallum State School Community Partnership – Q&A

#### How does the program work?

Families place their orders directly through the Fresh Box website [www.freshbox.com.au](http://www.freshbox.com.au) using the school code **CHEVSS** at checkout.

Orders are delivered directly to the parent's home or workplace, no collection from the school is required for families within our delivery area.

---

#### How does the school receive funds?

- 7.5% of all sales placed using the school code are returned to the P&C.
- An additional \$50 contribution is made in any month where total sales exceed \$2,000.
- Commission is calculated monthly and paid directly to the P&C.

Commissions are calculated at the end of each calendar month and paid shortly thereafter.

---

#### What do families receive?

- Certified organic fruit and vegetable boxes
- Flexible weekly ordering
- Complimentary home delivery on orders of \$100 or more exclusive to our community partnership within the Fresh Box delivery area. Orders under \$100 are welcome; standard delivery fees apply.

Families may share the school code with relatives or friends who live within the Fresh Box delivery area to further support the school community.

#### Are the produce boxes set?

Families can choose what suits them best.

We offer value mixed produce boxes, which are pre-designed seasonal selections, or families can build their own box by selecting individual items from our extensive certified organic range.

In addition to fruit and vegetables, we also offer pantry items, dairy and locally baked sourdough.
