Chevallum State School has become a Gold Maths Active School, an initiative of the Qld Association of Mathematics Teachers.

The Queensland Association of Mathematics Teachers' Maths Active School Initiative is a way to recognise and support schools who demonstrate effective learning and teaching practices in mathematics.

It means there are structures in place at a whole school level to ensure there is a strong emphasis on developing mathematics learning and teaching.

Some features of Chevallum as a Gold level Maths Active School include:

- Whole school mathematics planning that caters for diversity and strives to maximise the learning of each student
- Mathematical games days, investigations with each year level, and involvement in mathematics competitions
- Teachers attending mathematically based professional development both in school and external sessions and contributing to these professional learning communities through sharing of practice at workshops
- Mathematics classrooms where a range of concrete materials, relevant ICT and games are being utilised to develop understanding, fluency, problem-solving and reasoning skills
- Co-operative, small-group learning alongside whole-class discussion where students are questioning, analysing, justifying and explaining mathematics in order to improve confidence and positive mindsets
